

## Objectives of reform process:

Clear and simple regulation;

Systematic approach;

Concept of two Acts:

- Copyright and Neighbouring Rights Act;
- Industrial Property Act;
- Importance of regulatory impact assessment

Openness of process;

- Open dialogue;
