**Question 3:** Please describe very important topics of the constitutional jurisprudence in the member states concerning the participation in the process of European integration (please give examples)

- see the Transparency films, p. 13 - 15 and Diagram 2. *Basic questions:* in particular the protection of fundamental rights in the Union, the limits of the primacy of Union law (in particular the protection of constitutional identity), the relationship between the ECJ and the national constitutional courts, the enforcement of the limits of the competences of the Union; *special problems:* in particular the ratification of the Reform Treaties of Maastricht, Amsterdam and Lisbon, the obligation to transpose directives and the implementation of the European arrest warrant
